This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 17, of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. Any further increase shall require prior approval of the Board, subject to compliance with affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of 500 sq. ft. dimension.

2	The front portion of the boundary wall is below 6 feet. The school is required to construct the concrete boundary wall of 6 feet height and submit the compliance on the SARAS portal within three months .
3	The name board of the school at the entrance has been temporarily fixed. The school is required to permanently fix the name board prominently at the entrance of the school and submit the compliance on the SARAS portal within three months.
4	The school is required to create storage facility in Physics lab and upgrade their stock. The Biology Lab should also be equipped with more materials and storage facility to be done. The school is advised to upgrade all the labs, library and sports facilities in the light of the SoPs issued by the Board vide circular no. 11 dt. 04.10.2022 and submit the compliance on the SARAS portal within three months.
5	The entry to the Composite Science Lab is on an uneven surface. The school is required to construct a ramp to make the Lab accessible to CWSN students and submit the compliance on the SARAS portal within three months.
6	The Washrooms do not have a main door which prevents privacy to the students. The school is required to fix a door at the entrance of all washrooms and submit the compliance on the SARAS portal within three months.
7	CWSN boys toilet on ground floor and CWSN girls toilet on first floor was seen. Only signage was shown in other cases. Walkers should not be placed near the toilet seat. The school is required to make provision for CWSN toilets separately for boys and girls as per the specifications prescribed in RPwD Act 2016 and Circular no. 5 dated 6.3.2023 issued by the Board. The school should submit the compliance on the SARAS portal within three months.
8	Reading area for staff in the library is to be created and submit the compliance on the SARAS portal within three months.
9	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Bhopal within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by

the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.

5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.
